**We, J. Calvin Paris and Geraldine Paris**

SEND GREETING

**WHEREAS, we** the said **J. Calvin Paris and Geraldine Paris**

in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date with these Presents, are well and truly indebted unto the **CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C.**, in the full and just sum of **One Thousand Five Hundred and no/100 - - - - - (\$ 1,500.00 )** Dollars, with interest from the date hereof at the rate of **seven** per cent ( **7** %) per annum, unpaid interest to bear interest at the same rate, to be repaid in installments of

**Twenty-three and 75/100 - - - - - (\$ 23.75 )** dollars

due and payable on the 5th day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest and all costs, insurance, and expenses incurred in connection with said loan, has been paid, said monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, and then to payment of principal, costs, expenses and insurance, if any, incurred; and said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due hereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of sixty (60) days, or upon failure to comply with any of the by-laws of said Association, or with any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall at the option of the holder become immediately due and payable, and said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed with an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind.

**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we** the said **J. Calvin Paris and Geraldine Paris**

in consideration of the said debt and sums of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said **CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C.**, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of **Three (\$3.00) Dollars** to us the said mortgagor, in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C.**, its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of **Greenville, Chick Springs Township, old Ansel School District**, and lying on the southwest side of the old **Ansel (Paved) School House Road**, and having the following courses and distances to wit:

**BEGINNING** at the corner of **Amanda Southern's** lands on the southwest side of said road, and runs thence with said road northwesterly two hundred ten (210) feet to the **T. C. Rollins** line; thence with the **Rollins** and parallel with the **Amanda Southern** line, two hundred ten (210) feet, in a northeastern direction; thence in a southeastern direction and parallel with the **Ansel School Road**, two hundred ten (210) feet, on the **Rollins** corner; thence with the **Rollins** line and back to the said **Ansel School Road** in a southwestern direction, two hundred ten (210) feet, the beginning corner, and containing one (1) acre, more or less; and being a part of the same lands conveyed to **T. C. Rollins** by **Mrs. Amanda Southern Hargrove**, January 12th, 1955, and recorded in **R. M. C. Office, Vol. 561, page 155**.
