The Morninger covenants that he is lawfully enzed of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple all solute, that herebas good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises were free and clear of all lights and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further equenants towarrant and forever, defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagor forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

I've The Mortghgor covenants and agrees as follows:

- If That he will promptly pay the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said note, at the timestand in the manner therein provided. The inortgages may collect a "late charge" not to exceed an amount equal to five per continuous (5%) of any installment which is not paid within fifteen (15) days from the due date thereof 10 cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments.
- 22 That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein, and also any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagor by the Mortgagee; and that all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the Mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That he will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and other hazards, in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that he does hereby assign to the Mortgagee all such policies, and that all such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee and have attached theseto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee.
- 5.4. That he will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected upon the mortgaged property in good repair, and should he fail to do so, the Mortgagee may at its option, enter upon said premises, make whatever grepairs are necessary, and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt
- 5. That the Mortgagee may require the maker, co maker or endorsor of any indebtedness secured hereby to carry life insurance upon himself in a sum sufficient to pay all sums secured by this mortgage, designating the Mortgagee as beneficiary thereof, and, upon failure of the Mortgagor to pay the premiums therefor, the Mortgagee may, at its option, pay said premiums, and all sums so advanced by the Mortgageo shall become a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6. That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the ternis of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Mortgagee, on the field day of each pronth, until the indebtedness secured hereby is paid in full, a sum equal to one-twelfth of the annual taxes, public dissessments and insurance premiums, as estimated by the Mortgagee, and, on the failure of the Mortgagor to pay all taxes, insurance premiums and public assessments, the Mortgagee may, at its option, pay said items and charge all advances therefor to the mortgage debt, including, also, any State and Federal tax liens.
- 7. That he hereby assigns all the rents, issues, and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Mortgageo shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings and the execution of his trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
- 8. That, at the option of the Mortgagee, this mortgage shall become due and payable forthwith if the Mortgager shall convey away said mortgaged premises, or if the title shall become vested in any other person in any maning whatsoever other than by death of the Mortgagor.
- 9. It is agreed that the Mortgagor shall hold and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mortgage or in the note secured hereby. It is the true meaning of this instrument that if the Mortgagor shall fully perform all the terms, condition, and covenants of this mortgage, and of the note secured hereby that then this martgage shall be utterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. If there is a default in any of the terms, conditions or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgagee, all sums then owing by the Mortgager to the Mortgagee shall become immediately due and payable, and this mortgage may be foreclosed. Bhould any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgagee become a party to any suit involving this Mortgage or the litle to the premises described herein or should the debt secured hereby of any part thereof be placed in the hands of an attorney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and expenses incurred by the Mortgagee, and a reasonable attorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and payable immediately or on demand, at thre option of the Mortgagee, as a part of the debt secured thereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.

10. The covenants herein contained shall bind, and the benefits and advantages shall inure to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular number shall include the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders.
