Galloway by Gooch & Taylor, Surveyors, dated July 23, 1952, and recorded in Plat Book 28 at pages 380-382, R.M.C. Office for Spartanburg County, containing 4.85 acres, more or less, and being bounded on the northwest by Piedmont & Northern Railway right of way, on the northwest by Iot No. 6 as shown on said plat, and on the south and west by a branch which separates this tract from the land of Cleveland. This is the same property conveyed to Cecils Land and Improvement Company by deed of David W. Galloway, et al. recorded in Deed Book 18-Z at page 554, R.M.C. Office for Spartanburg County, which deed is being recorded again to correct certain scrivener's errors, Reference is specifically made to said deed and plat and the records thereof in aid of description.
