To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Fifteen Thousand and No/100 -- (\$15,000,00) Dollars (or for future advances which may be made hereunder at the option of said Association, which advances shall not exceed the maximum amount stated herein and shall be evidenced by a subsequent promissory note or notes se-

cured hereby), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate specified therein in installments of

One Hundred Sixty-Six and 54/100 -- - (\$ 166.54) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid, such ances, and then to the payment of the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal. The last payment on said note, if not paid earlier and if not subsequently

extended, will be due and payable 10 years after date. The note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for afferiod of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the Hy-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said rate, shall, at the option of the holder, become immediately due and payable, and the holder may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN. That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money of processed, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargained sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville, on the south side of College Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of College Street, corner of lot sold to George Norwood, and running thence along line of said Norwood lot, S. 20-54 W. 100 feet to an iron pipe; thence along lot of Parrish & Gower, S. 21-27 W. 45.1 feet to an iron pipe on Earle property; thence along said line, N. 67-45 W. 21.2 feet to an iron pin; thence along line of Green property, N. 18-40 E. 49.4 feet to an iron pin; thence still along Green line, N. 50-01 W. I foot to point; thence N. 20-54 E. 100 feet to a stake on south side of College Street; thence along south side of said street, S. 58-01 E. 25 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by C. F. Haynsworth by deed dated July 15, 1936 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 188, page 39; this conveyance is subject to the right conveyed by J. Hudson Williams to A. F. McKissick, his heirs and assigns, to tie to the west wall of building situate on said lot, and the right conveyed by C. F. Haynsworth to Sam Konduros, his heirs and assigns, to tie to the east wall of the building situate on said lot."
