"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of and, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 43, Block D, of East Park, plat of which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book A, Page 383, and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southerly side of East Washington Street, at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 42 and 43, and running thence with the line of said lots, S. 17-30 E. 175 feet to an fron pin on Boyce Springs Avenue; thence along Boyce Springs Avenue in a northeasterly direction 50 feet; thence N. 117-30 W. 175 feet to an iron pin on East Washington Street; thence along East Washington Street in a southwesterly direction 50 feet to the point of beginning, being identically the same property conveyed to mortgagor by deed recorded in Deed Book 82, Page 14.
