WHEREAS, I/we the inforesaid mortgagor (s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Two Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100 - 4, 2, 500.00). Dollars (or for luttire advances which may be made hereunder at the option of said Association, which advances shall not exceed the maximum amount, stated herein and shall be evidenced by a subsequent promissory note or notes se-

curled horaby), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate specified therein in installments of

Twatty, Five and No/100 - (\$ 25,00 *) Dollars upon the first day of each and every chlendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid, such monthly payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal.
