BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwest corner of the intersection of Byrd Boulevard, formerly Ridge Drive, and Riverside Drive, and running thence along the northern side of Riverside Drive, in a southwesterly direction, 200 feet to an Iron pin at the corner of a ten foot alley; thence along the northeastern side of said ten foot alley, in a northwesterly direction 165 feet to an Iron pin a the rear corner of Lot No. 16; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 16 and 17, in a northeasterly direction, 200 feet to an Iron pin on the southwestern side of Byrd Bullevard; thence along the southwestern side of Byrd Boulevard in a southeasterly direction, 165 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to us to Julius F.
