(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southwest side of White Horse Road, in Gantt Township, being shown and designated as Lot No. 7, Block 1, page 252, of the County Block Book, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of White Horse road, at corner of property now or formerly owned by Robert J. Southerland and running thence with the line of said property S. 31-20 W. 322 feet, more or less, to pin at corner of lot heretofore conveyed to Carmel Clardy; thence with the line of said lot in a southeasterly direction 98 feet, more or less, to pin on Sandra Street; thence with the western side of said street N. 31-20 E. 289 feet, more or less, to iron pin at the intersection of Sandra Street and White Horse Road; thence with the southwest side of the right of way of White Horse Road N. 41-48 W. 102 feet to the point of beginning.
