NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Montgage at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, situate at the northeast corner of the intersection of Second Avenue and Seventh Street, and being shown and designated as Lot 61, Section 4, on plat of Judson Mills, recorded in Plat Book K at Pages 75 and 76, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Second Avenue, at the intersection of Seventh Street and Second Avenue, and running thence with Second Avenue, N. 6-18 E. 73 feet to pin at corner of Lot 62; thence N. 88-10 E. 157.8 feet to pin in line of Lot 60; thence with line of Lot 60, S. 1-42 E. 82.1 feet to pin on Seventh Street; thence with the northern side of Seventh Street 3. 88-10 W. 159.5 feet to pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Seventh Street and Second Avenue, the chord of which is N. 42-46 W. 13.1 feet to the point of beginning."
