The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

- That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sunts as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mo gages, for the payment of taxes, they arece premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgages for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. - (3) That it will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected in good repair, and, in the case of a construction loan, that it will continue construction until completion without interruption, and should it fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary, including the completion of any construction work underway, and charge the expenses for such repairs or the completion of such construction to the mortgage debt.
- (4) That it will pay, when due, all taxes, public assessments, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines or other impositions against the mortgaged premises. That it will comply with all governmental and municipal laws and regulations affecting the mortgaged premises.
- That it hereby assigns all rents, issues and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and agrees that, should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, any judge having jurisdiction may, at Chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver of the mortgaged premises, with full authority to take possession of the mortgaged premises and collect the rents, issues and profits, including a reasonable rental to be fixed by the Court in the event said premises are occupied by the mort-gagor and after deducting all charges and expenses attending such preceding and the execution of its trust as receiver; shall apply the residue of the rents, issues and profits toward the payment of the gebt secured hereby.
- (6) That if there is a default in any of the terms, conditions, or coverants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgagee, all sums then owing by the Moragagor to the Mortgagee shall become immediately due and payable, and this mortgage may be foreclosed. Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgagee become apparty of any suit involving this Mortgage or the title to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of any attorney at law for collection by suit or, otherwise, all costs and expenses incurred by the Mortgagee, and a reasonable attorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and payable immediately of demand, at the option of the Mortgagee, as part of the debt secured hereby and many he recovered and collected hereupons. - (7) That the Mortgagor shall hold and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mortgago or in the note secured hereby. It is the true meaning of this instrument that if the Mortgagor shall fully perform all the terms, conditions, and covenants of the mortgage, and of the note secured hereby, that then this mortgage shall be utterly null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
- (8) That the covenants herein contained shall bind, and the benefits and advantages shall inure to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular shall included the plural, the plural the singular,
