WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

C. DOUGLAS WILSON & CO.

a corporation organized and existing under the laws of State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Eleven Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$ 11,700.00), with interest from date at the rate of five & one-half per centum. (5 1/2 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, S.C. or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Eighty and 50/100 ----- Dollars (\$ 80.50), commencing on the first day of September, 19 61, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of August, 19 61.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate on the North side of Overbrook Road, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 50 as shown on a plat of Overbrook, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book E, Pages 251 and 252, and having, according to said plat, and a survey made by R.K. Campbell, July 6, 1961, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Overbrook Road which is located S. 89-05 W., 81 feet from the point of a curve at which Overbrook Road curves into Spruce Street, and running thence S. 89-05 W., 68 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 2-12 W., 94 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 3-45 W., 88.4 feet to an iron pin in the Southerly line of Walnut Street; thence with the curve of Walnut Street and Spruce Street (the chord being S. 37-04 E., 25 feet) to an iron pin on Spruce Street; thence with the curve of Spruce Street (the chord being S. 67-05 E., 33.5 feet) to an iron pin; thence S. 2-44 E., 32 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 6-11 E., 135.6 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Overbrook Road, the point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.
