BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwestern corner of the intersection of Tally Road (Talley Bridge Road) and Woodland Road and running thence along the northern side of said Tally Road, S. 74-12 W. 192 feet to a point; thence N. 5-12 W. 356.8 feet to a point; thence S. 76-20 E. 236.5 feet to an iron pin on the western side of said Woodland Road; thence with the western side of said Woodland Road, S. 8-56 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the western side of said Road, S. 5-13 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the western side of said Road, S. 4-17 E. 98.3 feet to the point of beginning; being the same property conveyed to Edgar F. Epps, C. O. Vaughan and Ralph Poole, as Trustees of the Slater Church of God and included within the above description is the property conveyed to Fields Masters, et al. as Trustees of the aforementioned Church of God by S. Slater & Sons, Inc. by deed dated May 15, 1939 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 210, at Page 418.
