, to be paid in Monthly installments first payment to be paid October 1st, 1st, 1961, in the amount of Twenty eight & 47/100 \$28.47 any payment not made on due date is to bear interest at 7% Semi-annually first payment due October 1st, 1961, and like amount to be paid the first day of each month thereafter until paid in full.

, with interest thereon from due date
Semi-Annually
at the rate of 7% per centum per annum, to be computed and paid. Semi-annually
