NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Bollars to me/us tife said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Grove Township, on the southeast side of Highway No. 29 and being known and designated as Lot No. 1 of a subdivision of the property of C. B. Dalton as shown on plat thereof made by Dalton & Neves in May of 1947 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book AA, at page 189, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the aoutheast side of Highway No. 29 at the corner of the lot now or formerly belonging to T. D. Simmons, and running thence S. 58-23 E. 204.7 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the northeast side of the railroads right-of-way, thence along said right-of-way. N. 27-42 E. 89.8 feet to riron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 2; thence along the line of that loss N. 58-15 W. 198.8 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the southeast side of Highway No. 29; thence along the southeast side of Highway No. 29; thence along the southeast side of Highway No. 29, S. 31-45 W. 90 feet to the beginning corner.

The above-described lot is the same lot as conveyed to H. E. Hawthorne and Lois G. Hawthorne by J. O. Jones by deed dated September 17, 1951 and recorded in the R.M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 442, page 92, and by a corrected deed dated October 29, 1951 and recorded in the R.M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 445, page 25, the aforesaid H. E. Hawthorne having since died, leaving as his sole heirs-at-law his widow, Lois G. Hawthorne, and his son, Heyward E. Hawthorne.
