BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwestern side of the Parker Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 4, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 38-30 W. 348.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 51-30 W. 187.5 feet to an iron pin in the center of the rear line of Lot No. 2; thence on a line through the center of Lot No. 2, N. 38-30 E. 348 5 feet to an iron pin on the southwestern side of Parker Road; thence along the southwestern side of the Parker Road, S. 51-30 E. 187.5 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by Victor-Monaghan Company by its deed dated October 14, 1936, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 185 at page 288 and by E. C. Burry, Jr. by his deed dated March 11, 1939 and recorded in the R.M.C.
