NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand paid by second party, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, in fee simple, and by these presents those grant, bargain, sell and release, in fee simple, unto second party, its successors and assigns, the following described lands, including but not limited to, all trees, timber, shrubbery, fixtures and improvements now and hereafter thereon:

All that piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, in Grove Township, and having the following metes and tounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at a stone on the western line, thence north 22 degrees west 12.75 chains to a stone on Carr's line; thence south 66 degrees east 7.20 chains to a stone pile; OM; thence north 7 degrees 15 minutes east 21,65 chains crossing a branch to a larger stone OM; thence south 28 degrees east 80 links to a stone OM; thence south 67 degrees east 2.25 chains to a stone OM; thence south 84 degrees 15 minutes east 13.40 chains to a cherry tree CM; thence south 15 degrees east 1.70 chains crossing a branch to a stone CM; thence south 15 degrees 30 minutes west 3.00 chains to a stone OM; thence south 39 degrees 45% minutes west 6.09 chains to a stone CM; thence south 20 degrees 15 minutes west 10.50 chains to a stone CM; thence north 89 degrees 45 minutes west 9.25 chains to a stone, the beginning corner, containing 39.56 acres, more or less, and being one of the parcels conveyed to Albert Taylor (otherwise known as Albert Q.
