All that piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Green-ville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southwest side of a 25 foot road running in a Northwesterly direction from the intersection of Columbia Avenue and Sumter Street, and being a part of that parcel or lot of land known and designated as Tract No. 39 on a plat of Riverside Farms made by P. H. Foster in August 1907, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "K", at Pages 100-103, and having according tosaid plat, the following metes and bounds:
