(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinatter referred to as Mortgages) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of --- Sixteen Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 --- by reference in the sum of DOLLARS (\$16,500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid in monthly instalments of --- One Hundred Six & No/100 --- Dollars (\$ 106.00) each on the first day of each month hereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid; each payment to be applied first to payment of interest and then to payment of principal, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, wits successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northwestern side of Camelback Road, being shown and designated as Lot 3 on plat of Canterbury Hills, Unit One recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book MM at Page 150, and being further described according to said plat as follows:

"HEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Camelback Road, at the joint front corner of Lots 2 and 3, and running thence along the line of Lot 2, N. 43-06 V. 145 feet to iron pin; thence S. 46-54 W. 100 feet to an dron pin at corner of Lot 4; thence along line of Lot 4, S. 43-06 E. 145 feet to dron pin on the northwestern side of Camelback Road; thence along the northwestern side of Camelback Road, N. 46-54 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner."

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagors by deed of Alfred C. Mann, dated October 20, 1961, to be recorded herewith.

It is understood that the within mortgage secures a loan insured by the Mortgage Guaranty Insurance Corporation. It is agreed that the mortgagee may at the expiration of ten years require the said loan to be insured by the Mortgage Guaranty Insurance Corporation for an additional period of five years at a premium amounting to not more than one-half of one per cent. of the principal balance then existing. It is further understood that this mortgage shall secure the mortgagee for any sum that may be advanced in payment of said insurance premium, and that all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the mortgagee.

Rogether with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting factures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
