WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagoe) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Nineteen Thousand and No/100

DOLLARS (\$ 19,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (67) per centum per annum, and principal and interest to be repaid in monthly instalments of One Hundred Twenty-Two and No/100 ---- Dollars (\$ 122.00) each on the first day of each month hereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid; each payment to be applied first to payment of interest and then to payment of principal, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgager for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, including advances made by the Mortgager on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgage at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgage, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgage at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Butler Township, on the Northwestern side of Shannon Lake Circle, being shown as Lot No. 11 on a revised Plat of Lots No. 10 and 11 of Shannon Forest, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book KK, Page 141, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Shannon Lake Circle, joint front corner of Lots No. 11 and 12, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 12, N. 42-25 W. 221 feet to a point on high water mark of Shannon Lake; thence with said high water mark, N. 27-45 E. 69.17 feet to pin at rear corner of Lot No. 10; thence with the new line of Lot No. 10, S. 51-23 E. 105.2 feet to pin; thence S. 71-26 E. 161.6 feet to pin on Shannon Lake Circle; thence with the Northwest side of said Circle, S. 47-35 W. 160 feet to the point of BEGINNING.

Being the same property conveyed to the Mortgagor by Deed of Louis A. Garlington, et al, to be recorded herewith.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD that the within mortgage secures a loan insured by the Mortgage Guaranty Insurance Corporation. It is agreed that the mortgagee may at the expiration of ten years require the said loan to be insured by the Mortgage Guaranty Insurance Corporation for an additional period of five years at a premium amounting to not more than one-half of one per cent of the principal balance then existing. That this mortgage shall secure the mortgagee for any sum that may be advanced in payment of said insurance premium, and that all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the mortgagee.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now of hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
