NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, altuate, lying and being in the Piedmont." Manufacturing Company Village in or near the Town of Piedmont, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot No. 48, Section 3, as shown on a plat entitled "Property of Piedmont Mfg. Co., Greenville," made by Dalton & Neves, February, 1950, Sections 3 and 4 of said plat are recorded in the R. M. C. Office of Greenville County in Plat Book Y, at pages 2-5, inclusive, and pages 6-9, inclusive, respectively. According to said plat the within described lot is also known as No. 18 Piedmont Street (Avenue) and fronts thereon 91 feet.
