WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor (s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents smo/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

The note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder, become immediately due and payable, and the holder may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor (s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor (s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, lying at the intersection of Stall Street and David Street, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 1 and 4 as shown on a plat of said property being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at Page 108 and having, according to a more recent survey prepared for David Street Baptist Church by Carolina Engineering and Surveying Co., dated November 3, 1961, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the partheastern side of David Street, joint front corner, of Lots Nos, 1 and 2 and running thence with David Street, N. 23-15 W. 60 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of David Street and Stall Street; thence with the southern side of Stall Street, N. 66-45 E. 116.65 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 23-15 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 2; thence S. 66-45 W. 46.65 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 23-15 W. 40 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 66-45 W. 70 feet to an iron pin on the northeastern side of David Street, the point of beginning; and being the same property conveyed to the mortgagors by three separate deeds being respectively recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 577, at Page 71, Deed Vol. 534, at Page 422 and Deed Vol. 525, at Page 463.
