WHEREAS, the said Sabothen, Inc.

is well and truly indebted to the Peoples National Bank of Greenville, S.C., as Trustee under Agreement with The Shriners Hospital for Crippled Children (General Endowment) in the full and just sum of Thirty-two Thousand and No/100ths \$32,000.00 DOLLARS, to be paid at

in Greenville, S. C., together with interest thereon from date hereof until maturity at the rate of five & one-half (5 1/2 %) per centum per annum, said principal and interest being payable in monthly installments as follows:
