NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate lying and being on the Southern side of Oak Hill Drive, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as portions of Lots Nos. 16 and 17, as shown on a plat prepared by J. C. Hill, R.L.S., dated November 30, 1957 entitled "Final Plat, Oak Hill, Sections A & B", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book MM at page 29 and being know and designated as Lot No. 17 as shown on a revised plat of Oak Hill, prepared by J. C. Hill, L.S., dated August 23, 1961, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book ZZ at page 39, and having according to said latter mentioned plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Oak Hill Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 17 and 18, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 18 S. 32-32 E. 170.4 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly of Rich; thence with the line of said Rich property S. 49-08 W. 77.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 51-48 W. 45 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 66-22 W. 26.2 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 16 and 17; thence with the line of Lot No. 16 N. 19-35 W. 156.7 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Oak Hill Drive; thence with the Southern side of Oak Hill Drive and following the curve thereof, N. 77-59 E. 67 feet to the point of beginning.
