reference, in the sum of Six Thousand Two Hundred Fifry and No/100-----

DOLLARS (\$6.250.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance of said debt or debts, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near Travelers Rest, S. C. in Bates Township, containing 2.52 acres, more or less, according to a plat entitled A. H. Harbin, made by J. C. Hill, dated May 23, 1955, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of the old Little Texas Road at Jack Garrett's corner and running thence with him, N. 37 E. 217.5 feet to an iron-pin; thence S. 56-10 E. along Claude Clamp 505.4 feet to an iron pin in the center of Little Texas Road; thence along the center of said road the following courses and distances, to-wit: S. 40 W. 133.6 feet to an iron pin; S. 84 W. 105 feet to an iron pin; N. 59 W. 424.4 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to Arzilla L. Harbin in Deed Book 526 at page 488. Subsequent to this conveyance the new Poinsett Highway, known as U.S. Highway 25, a four lane highway, has been cut through the western part of this property, leaving approximately 1.79 acres, more or less.
