All that piece parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being on the Eastern side of Calhoun Street in the City of Creenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as the Southern portion of Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 as shown on a plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book A at page 163, and having according to said plat, the following meter and bounds:
