"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Wildrose Lane, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 36 and 37; running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 33-30 W. 130 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 38; thence along joint line of Lots Nos. 37 and 38, N. 65-40 W. 126.8 feet to an iron pin on the easterly side of Borden Circle; thence along the easterly side of said Borden Circle, N. 33-30 E. 125 feet to an iron pin in the intersection of said Borden Circle and Wildrose Lane; thence with the curvature of said intersection, the chord of which is N. 78-30 E. 35.4 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Wildrose Lane; thence with the southern side of said Wildrose Lane, S. 56-30 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning; being a portion of the property conveyed to me by R. L. Childress by deed dated August 16, 1961 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 680, at Page 453."
