(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

DOLLARS (\$ 4,500.00 ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Richards, Greenville,

in Gan: t Township, on the south side of the old Anderson Road (State Highway No. 1), being known and designated as the front portion of Tract No. 18-A of the property of E. R. Parker, being a portion of "Dixie Farms" according to a plat thereof prepared by Dalton & Neves, December, 1939 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book L, at page 5, and having, according to a plat of the property of W. F. and Lorine Snyder prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, October 31, 1952, the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINLING at an aron pin in the center of the Old Anderson Road (S.C. Highway No. 81) at the joint front corner of Tracts 18 and 18-A (said point being witnessed by iron pin 28 feet on line), and running thence along the joint line of Tracts 18 and 18-A, S. 35-30-2. 228.6 feet to the center of a branch (said point being witnessed by iron in 10 feet on line); thence following said branch as the line, N. 53-48 E. 165.2 feet to a point on the line of Tract No. 19 (said point being witnessed by iron pin 8 feet on line); thence along the joint line of Tracts 18-A and 19, N. 32-54 W. 223.8 feet to a point in the center of S. C. Highway No. 81) said point being witnessed by iron pin 28 feet on line); thence along the center of S. C. Highway No. 81, S. 55-25 W. 175 feet to an iron in at the joint front corner of Tracts 18 and 18-A, the point of BEGINWING; being the identical property conveyed to William W. Gorman by Lorine H. Snyder by deed dated October 31, 1952, recorded in Volume 466, at page 147 in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina."
