NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Fairview Township, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the Eastern edge of the Babbtown Road, joint corner with land formerly belonging to H. A. Weathers, and runnin thence with said road N. 19 1/2 W. 145 feet to an iron pin, joint corner with lands formerly belonging to Stoddard; thence with the Stoddard line N. 40 E. 190 feet to an iron pin; thence 5. 19-1/2 E. 225 feet to an iron pin; thence in a Southwesterly direction 190 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning, and bounded by said belonging to H.
