ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying
and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and
in the City of Greenville, described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on Railroad Street and running thence
South 5-11 West 30.4 feet to a stake; thence North 77-30 West 125.4
feet to a stake; thence North 15 West 30 feet to a stake; thence
