NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgage at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the city of Greenville, situate on the west side of Pimlico Road, being shown as Lot No. 200 on plat of Section A, of Gower Estates made by Dalton and Neves, indineers, January 1960, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in plat book Q2, pages 146 and 147, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Pimlico Road at joint front corner of Lots 10B and 109, and runs thence along the line of lot 108, S. 74-16 W. 169 feet to a point in the center of a branch; thence frong the center of the branch (the traverse line being N. 16-51 W. 129.6 t) to a point in the center of the branch; thence along the line of Log 10, N. 83-46 E. 181 feet to an iron pin on the west side of Pimlico Road; thence with the curve of Pimlico Road (the chord being S. 11-44 E. 100 feet) to the beginning corner.
