NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgage at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being shown as Lot #78 on plat of University Park made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, November, 1946, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book P, page 127 and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Bradley Boulevard at joint front corner of Lots 78 and 79 and running thence along the line of Lot, 79, N 37-34 W, 157.7 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Brookside Circle; thence with Brookside Circle, N 59-03 E, 75.5 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Brookside Circle and Stephen Lane; thence along the Southwest side of Stephen Lane S 37-34 E, 149 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Stephen Lane and Bradley Boulevard; thence along the Northwest side of Bradley Boulevard, S 52-26 W, 75 feet to the beginning corner.
