To ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Thomas E. Cannon, Jr., of Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send (s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto C. Douglas Wilson & Co.

a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of --Seventy-Six Hundred and no/100-- Dollars (\$ 7,600.00), with interest from date at the rate of Five and one-fourth per centum (5-1/4%) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, South Carolina or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of -----Forty-Five and 60/100----- Dollars (\$ 45.60), commencing on the first day of June, 19 62, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of May, 19 87.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being at the northeastern intersection of Donnon Road and Bob White Lane, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as a greater portion of Lot No. 15 of a subdivision known as-Super Highway Home Sites, Plat of which is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "P" at Page 53, and according to a later plat by R. B. Bruce for Thomas E. Cannon, Jr., dated April 24, 1962, has the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Donnon Road at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 14 & 15, and running thence with the eastern side of Donnon Road, S. 2-00 W. 90 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Donnon Road and Bob White Lane which intersection is curved the chord of which is S 45-52 E., 33.6 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Bob White Lane; running thence with the northern side of Bob White Lane, N. 86-15 E. 57 feet to an iron pin; running thence along a new line through Lot 15, N. 14-32 E., 55.9 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along a new line through Lot 15, N. 4-51 W., 53.1 feet to an iron pin; running thence N. 88-00 W. 83 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

To HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the
