TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Iola E. Mathews,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor), SENDS GREETING

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GRUER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S.C., hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee, as evidenced by the Mortgage promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

thirty-five hundredDOLLARS \$3500.00, with interest thereon from date of the note six & one-half (6 1/2) percentum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sum or sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account by taxes, insurance premium, public account, repair, or for any other purpose;

I, NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that the Mortgagor, in consideration of the above debt and in order to secure payment thereof and of any other and further sum for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars \$3.00 to the Mortgagee being well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the closing and delivery of the premises, the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and delivered and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and deliver unto the Mortgagee all my right, title, and interest

in all that certain piece of ground with all improvements thereon, or hereafter acquired thereon, situated, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, One-half toward Up, on the east side of the Groce Meadow Road between Green and Mountain View School, containing 10.1 acres, more or less, and being in portion, tract No. 4 of the property of Thomas W. Smith according to original survey and plan of T. J. Bruegman, Surveyor dated October 4, 1863, and subsequent new lines established by T. P. Bill, surveyor, in 1865, the said tract containing the following bearings and distances, to wit:

Beginning at a point in Groce Meadow Road, running due East of house of Mrs. Turner, formerly owned by Mrs. Marie Bill, and running thence a long said road, N. 45-15 E. along 467 feet to an iron pin, new corner; thence N. 33 E. 27 feet to iron pin; thence N. 27-45 E. 30-00 feet to iron new corner; thence N. 07-30 E. 500 feet to corner, then thence thence N. 00 E. 20 feet to E. corner N. 00-15 E. 1114 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property covered by lot line map in record book No. 1, page 10, given this day of May, 1963.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or pertaining, and all of the chattels and goods which may arise or be had therfrom, and including all heating, plumbing and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, inserted, or fitted thereto in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
