per centum per annum

A certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements
thereon, and being on the northerly side of Old U. S. Highway No. 29, in the
County of Greenville, S. C., being shown as Lots 62 and 63 on a plat of part of the
property of Alfred Taylor, recorded in the REC Office for Greenville County, S. C.
in Book 100, page 74, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the northerly side of Old U. S. Highway No. 29, said stake
being the joint front corner of Lots 61 and 62, and running thence along the northerly
