"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Howell Circle, Joint front corner of Lots #3 and #4 and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 34-24 W. 222.2 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot #2; thence with the line of Lot #2, N. 65-35 W. 209 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 38-00 E. 177.6 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots #4 and #5; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 23-15 W. 114.7 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Howell Circle; thence with Howell Circle, N. 85-57 W. 71.2 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with Howell Circle, following the curvature thereof, S. 63-10, W. 65.1 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to us by Marion G. Clardy by his deed dated December 30, 1961 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 689, at Page 365.
