TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said promises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, of encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons what was a supply the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor covenants and agrees as follows:

- 1. That he will promptly pay the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the said note, at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein, and also any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager by the Mortgagee, and that all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the Mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgager, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That he will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and other hazards, in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that he does hereby assign to the Mortgagee all such policies, and that all such policies and renewals therefol shall be held by the Mortgagee and have attached therefol or other hazards, the Mortgagee may, at its option, apply and proceeds of the insurance to the mortgage indebtedness or to the restoration or repair of the property damaged.
- 4. That he will keep all improvements now existing of hereafter erected upon the mortgaged property in good repair, and should he fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at it of priority, enter upon said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary, and charge the expenses for such penairs to the appring debt.
- 55—That the Mortgagee may require the maker, comment or endorser of any indebtedness secured hereby to arry life insurance upon himself in a sum sufficient to pay all sums secured by this mortgage, designating the Mortgage as beneficiary thereof, and, upon failure of the Mortgage to pay the premiums therefor, the Mortgagee may as its option, pay said premiums, and all sums so advanced by the Mortgagee shall become a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6: That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Morrageie, on the first day of each month, until the indebtedness secured hereby is paid in full, a sum equal to one twelfth of the annual taxes, public assessments and insurance premiums, as estimated by the Mortgagee, and, on the failure of the Mortgage to pay all taxes, insurance premiums and public assessments, the Mortgagee may, at its option, pay say trends and charge all advances, therefor to the mortgage debt.
- 7. That he hereby assigns all the rents, issues, and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default bereunder, and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Mortgagee shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents issues, and sprofits who, after deducting all charges and expenses trending such proceedings and the execution of his trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
- 8. That, at the option of the Mortgagee, this mortgage shall become due and payable forthwith if the Mortgagor shall convey away said mortgaged premises, or if the title shall lecome vested in any other person in any manner what oever other than by death of the Mortgagor.
- 9. It is agreed that the Mortgagor shall hold and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mortgage or in the note secured hereby. It is the tell including of this instrument that if the Mortgagor, shall fully perform all the terms, conditions, and coverings of the profit and of the note secured hereby, that the mortgage shall be utterly null and void, otherwise specially interested hereby, then he thereby is default in the terms, conditions or covenants of this mortgage, of the note secured hereby, then he the option of the Mortgagee, all sums then owing by the Mortgagor to the the gage shall become immediately due and payable, and this mortgage may be foreclosed. Should any legal proceedings be infittitude for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgagee become a party to any suit involving this Mortgage or the title to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of an attorney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all costs and expenses incurred by the Mortgagee, and a reasonable attorneys fee, shall thereupon become due and payable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgagee, as a part of the debt secured thereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.
- 10. The covenants herein contained shall bind, and the benefits and advantages shall insure to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular number shall pelude the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders.
