KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, on the Eastern side of an unnamed Street, leading from Washington Avenue and according to survey of property of Zet Smith made by J. Mac Richardson in April, 1951, is described as follows:

BEGINAINO at a stake on the Eastern side of said 30 foot street, at corner of property of Bertha Boyd, which is also 157.5 feet South from the property of O. C. Fleming and running thence with the Bertha Boyd Property, S. 57-00 E. 210 feet to a stake; thence S. 34-00 E. 52.5 feet to a stake; thence N. 57-00 W. 210 feet to a stake; thence N. 34-00 E. 52.5 feet to the point of beginning.

Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagor by deed recorded in the Deed Book 391 at Page 415.
