(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Eight Thousand and no/100 DOLLARS (\$ 8,000.00); with interest thereon from date at the rate of Five & Three-fourths per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid in monthly instalments of Fifty-six Dollars (\$56.00) each on the first day of each month hereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid; each payment to be applied first to payment of interest and then to payment of principal, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, situate at the intersection of Parker Road and Old Buncombe Road, in Paris Mountain Township, containing 4.92 acres, and having according to plat made by Jones and Sutherland, February 1959, the following metes and bounds:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin in center of Old Parker Road and running thence with center of said Road N. 52-21 W. 222.9 feet to pin in center of Old U. S. Highway 25; thence with center of said Highway N. 6-32 W. 84.8 feet; N. 4-47 W. 100 feet; N. 0-17 E. 134 feet to pin in center of bridge; thence N. 39-06 E. 163.5 feet to point at bend of branch; thence continuing with branch the following courses and distances, S. 65 E. 145 feet; S. 84-03 W. 178.2 feet; N. 51-09 E. 181.7 feet to pin; thence S. 24-32 E. 13.2 feet to pin; thence S. 16 W. 366.5 feet to pin; thence S. 39-40 W. 135.1 feet to pin; thence N. 68-55 W. 383.4 feet to pin; thence S. 4-24 W. 278.4 feet to pin in center of Old Parker Road, the point of beginning."

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagor by two separate deeds, recorded in Volume 618 at Page 47 and Book 619 at Page 99, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging on in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
