That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter, constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, about one mile east of Brushy Creek Baptist Church, lying on the north side of the Brushy Creek Road (upper route) being a part of the same land conveyed to Lucile Annie Yluge by deed from H.
