That the Mortgagee may require the maker, co-maker or endorser of any indebtedness secured hereby to carry life insurance upon himself in a sum sufficient to pay all sums secured by this mortgage, designating the Mortgagee as beneficiary thereof, and, upon failure of the Mortgagor to pay the premiums therefor, the Mortgagee may, at its option, pay said premiums, and all sums so advanced by the Mortgagee shall become a part:

That, together with, and in addition to, the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note secured hereby, he will pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each month, until the indebted. ness secured hereby, is paid in full, a sum equal to one-twelfth pethe annual taxes, public assessments and insurance premiums, as estimated by the Mortgagee, and, on the failure of the Mortgager to pay, all taxes, insurance premiums and public assessments, the Mortgagee may at its option, pay said items and charge all advances therefor to the mortgage debt.

That he hereby assigns all the rents, issues, and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Mortgagee shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings and the execution of his trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.

If there is a default in any of the terms, conditions or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgagey, all sums then ofting by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee shall become immediately due and payable and this mortgage may be coreclosed. Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgage become a party to any suit involving this Mortgage or the title to the premises described berein, or should the dight secured hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of an attorney at law for collection by suit altotherwise, all costs and expenses incurred by the Mortgagee, and a reason. able attorney's fee, shall thereippen begoine due and payable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgagee, as a part of the debt secured thereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder,
