TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: We, Maurice T. Belue, and Patsy C. Belue,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

Eleven Thousand -----
DOLLARS (\$11,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%)
per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, on the west side of Woodland Drive near the limits of the City of Greer and northward therefrom, being designated as Lot No. 15 of a subdivision known as PINEBROOK according to survey and plat by H.S. Brockman, Registered Surveyor, dated February 21, 1935, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 77, page 290, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at a stake on the west side of Woodland Drive, corner of Lots Nos. 14 and 15, and running thence along the line of the same, S. 82-00 W. 203 feet to a stake on the brook; thence up said brook as a line, S. 23-48 E. 103.4 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 16; thence along the line of Lot No. 16, N. 79-30 E. 175 feet to a stake on the west side of Woodland Drive; thence along the west side of said Drive, N. 8-00 W. 92 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the mortgagors herein by Marion C. Ponder, Jr. and Harriett M. Ponder by deed of even date, to be recorded herewith.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
