BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northerly side of Rollinggreen Road, joint front corner of lots 241 and 242, Sector V, and running thence along the common line of said lots N. 25-03 E. 147.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 54-18 W. 182.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34-53 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 240 and 241; thence along the common line of said lots, S. 34-14 E. 173.3 feet to an iron pin on the northerly side of Rollinggreen Road; thence along said Road, on an arc, the chord of which is S. 88-37 E. 25 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said Road on an arc, the chord of which is S. 54-51 E. 25 feet to the point of beginning.
