the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained,
exchanged, sold and released; and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its
successors and assigns.All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate,
lying and being on the Southwestern side of Somerset Avenue (formerly East King Street) near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State
of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 67 and the
westerly half of Lot No. 66 as shown on a plat of Anderson Street,
Greenville, prepared by Dalton Hayes, in 1934, recorded in the R.M.C.
Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book J at page
157, and having in the acreage, according to said plat, the following
edges and bounds:BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Somerset Avenue
(formerly East King Street) at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 67
