Dollars, in and by its certain promissory note in writing, of even date herewith, due and payable on or before six (6) months, from date hereof, and upon demand thereafter,

with interest from date hereof, at the rate of Five and one-half (5 1/2) percentum until paid; interest to be computed and paid Semi-Annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including ten per cent of the indebtedness as attorney's fee, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon situate, lying, and being on the northern side of Jacob Road in Pine Hill Village, Cantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, shown and designated as Lot 15 on a plat of Pine Hill Village prepared by R. K. Campbell, R.L.S., dated November 30, 1960, and recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. for said County and State in Plat Book QQ at Page 169, and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Jacob Road, joint front corner of Lots 14 and 15, and running thence N. 29-22 E. 140 feet along the joint line of said lots to an iron pin, joint rear corner of said lots in the line of Lot 22; thence N. 60-35 W. 70 feet along the joint line of Lots 15, 22, and 21 to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 15 and 16 in the line of Lot 21; thence S. 29-22 W. 140 feet along the joint line of Lots 15 and 16 to an iron pin on the northern side of said Road, joint front corner of said lots; thence S. 60-45 E. 70 feet along the northern side of said Road to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
