TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, Felton B. Alewine

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto W. Frank Cagle

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of

FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND NO/100 ----- Dollars (\$ 5,500.00 ) due and payable

In equal monthly payments of \$65.00 beginning August 1, 1962, and \$65.00 on the first day of each month thereafter until paid in full;

with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, to be paid: Semi-annually.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and being in Oaklawn Township, being composed of two tracts known as Tract No. 3 and Tract No. 5 on a plat made by J. Mac Richardson, Real Land Surveyor, in April, 1947, described as a whole, the said land is bounded by lands now or formerly on the Northwest by C. W. Owens; on the Northeast by lands of J. D. Chastain; on the Southeast by lands of Brady; and on the Southwest by the Saluda River and the said Brady. The said lands are fully described by courses and distances and metes and bounds on the Richardson plat, which is recorded in Plat Book "O", Page 185, RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina. Reference is here made to the plat for a more detailed description. The parcel shown on the plat as Tract No. 3, and containing 24 acres was conveyed to the said W. Frank Cagle by Annie Dunlan and others by deed dated November 23, 1940, recorded in Deed Book 223, Page 35, RMC Office, Greenville County, South Carolina. The parcel shown as Tract No. 5 on the said plat containing 23.4 acres, was conveyed to the said W. Frank Cagle by Dora Hagwell and others by deed dated November 30, 1940, recorded in Deed Book 224, Page 125.

together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
