

US-1—FIRST MORTGAGE ON REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: W. Forrest F. Dixon and
Paye P. Dixon, hereinafter referred to as (Mortgagor). SEND(S) GREETING

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Sixty-two Hundred and Fifty -----
DOLLARS (\$ 6250.00) with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance, premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars \$3.00 to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, on the northern side of Virginia Avenue near the City of Greer (now in the new City Limits of Greer), and being known and designated as Lot No. 26 on Plat of Development No. 2, Victor-Monaghan Company, Division of J.F. Stevens & Co., Inc., Greerplant, prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April, 1947, recorded in the office of the R.M.C for Greenville County in Plat Book "P", page 119, having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the northern side of Virginia Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 28 and 29, and runs thence along the common line of said lots, N. 35-21 E. 170 feet to the edge of a 10-foot alley reserved for utilities; thence along said alley, S. 54-39 E. 105 feet to a point on the edge of the said alley at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 27 and 28; thence along the common line of said lots, S. 35-21 W. 170 feet to a point on the northern side of Virginia Avenue; thence along Virginia Avenue, N. 54-39 W. 105 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the Mortgagors herein by deed of John T. Jones, recorded in Deed Book Page 270, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits (which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
