TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: We, Hattie V. Henderson and Joe R. Henderson, (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor, is well and truly indebted unto GREER FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREER, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

Twenty-eight Hundred ----- DOLLARS (\$ 2800.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Oneal Township, near Washington Baptist Church, on the north side of the Gap Creek Road, bounded on the east side by property formerly belonging to Washington School, bounded on the north by property of Washington Baptist Church and the Bomar Estate, on the west by lands of Heland Atkins, formerly Dan Ray, and on the south by said road. This tract contains 7 acres, more or less, and includes the old Ross home house, now the home of Hattie V. Henderson, and the new dwelling house constructed by Joe R. Henderson on lot conveyed to him by deed of Hattie V. Henderson recorded in Deed Book 588, page 246, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County. This is a portion of the property conveyed to Hattie V. Henderson by deed of Amanda E. Roe recorded in Deed Book 180, page 156, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
