TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

James B. Arrowood
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Eight Thousand and no/100 DOLLARS (\$8,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid in monthly instalments of Sixty and no/100 Dollars (\$ 60.00) each on the first day of each month hereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, each payment to be applied first to payment of interest and then to payment of principal, and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also, in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Western corner of White Horse Road and Page Drive near the City of Greenville, being shown as lot No. 3 on a plat of property of Lula B. Thruston recorded in Plat Book PP at Page 101 and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Western corner of White Horse Road and Page Drive and running thence with the Northwestern side of Page Drive S. 69-00 W. 121.8 feet to an iron pin at the corner of lot No. 6; thence with the line of said lot No. 21-00 W. 103.7 feet to an iron pin at the corner of lot No. 4; thence with the line of said lot N. 59-55 E. 128 feet to an iron pin on White Horse Road; thence with the southwestern side of said lot S. 29-25 E. 101.2 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Page Drive; thence with the curve of the intersection, the chord of which is S. 19-46 W. 30.1 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor by Malcolm G. Thruston by deed recorded herewith.
