PARTIAL RELEASE  
REAL ESTATE MORTGAGE

Know all men that this 27th day of July, 1962,  
 I, John H. Hild, hereinafter called the mortgagee, and O.  
Garvey and Helen E. Garvey, hereinafter called the mortgagors,  
 do hereby release the mortgagors by indenture of mortgage, bearing  
 date of January 15, 1962, as recorded in the S. N. C. Office for  
 Greenville County for South Carolina in Mortgage Book 882, at page  
 117, and all the considerations and for the purposes therein men-  
 tioned, the premises herein described; and  
 do hereby release the mortgagors have and this date mortgaged  
 premises and all the property of the mortgagors and the  
 parties called a guarantors and co-obligors for payment of the  
 note mentioned in the mortgage;

And I, the said John H. Hild, do hereby certify that the  
 release hereinabove made is free and clear from the lien of the  
 mortgage mentioned, together with all of its appurtenances, the tenements,  
 and all the other things and interests therein are in anywise  
 specified; and I do hereby certify that the title and interest of the  
 mortgagors, O. Garvey, and Helen E. Garvey, to the intent that the lands  
 hereby released and released shall forever be discharged from the  
 mortgage, and all the rest of the lands in the mortgage specified,  
 shall remain to the mortgagors, as hereinafter.

All of these lots of land, with the buildings and improvements  
 thereon, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina,  
 being known and designated as Lots Nos. 14, 15 and 17 on Plat of  
 "Greenview Hills", recorded in Plat Book 58, at page 147 in the  
 S. N. C. Office for Greenville County and having according to said  
 plat and a recent survey made February, 1960, by R. W. Dalton,  
 the following bearings and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at the iron pin on the northern side of Honeysuckle Lane,  
 thence N. 70-45 E. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence with the  
 line of said lots Nos. 14 and 15; thence with the  
 line of said lots Nos. 14 and 15; thence N. 70-45 E. 75 feet to an iron pin;  
 thence with the curve of said road as it intersects with Honeysuckle Lane, the chord of  
 which is 3-20-54 E. 31 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side  
 of said Honeysuckle Lane; thence S. 54-44 E. 81.8 to an iron pin;  
 thence N. 70-45 E. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 70-45 E.  
 75 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 75-10 E. 45 feet to an iron  
 pin; thence continuing with the northeast side of Honeysuckle Lane  
 N. 84-10 E. 45 feet to the beginning corner.
