## MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

BEGINNING on an iron pin on the joint corners of Lots no. 3 and 4 on the N/S of State-Road no. 186 and running with the common line of said lots, N 01-39 E, 177.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N 89-22 E, 131 feet to an iron pin on the W/S of Sycamore Drive; thence with said Sycamore Drive, S 11-45 E, 179.3 feet to an iron pin on the N/S of State Road no. 186; thence following said road, N 73-14 W, 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N 74-34 W, 100 feet to the point of beginning, being all of Lots no. 4 and 5 as shown on said plat, and being the same property conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of E. S. Guest and Terry F. Guest, August 24, 1961, as yet unrecorded.

Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or expertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had thereform, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and lingular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
